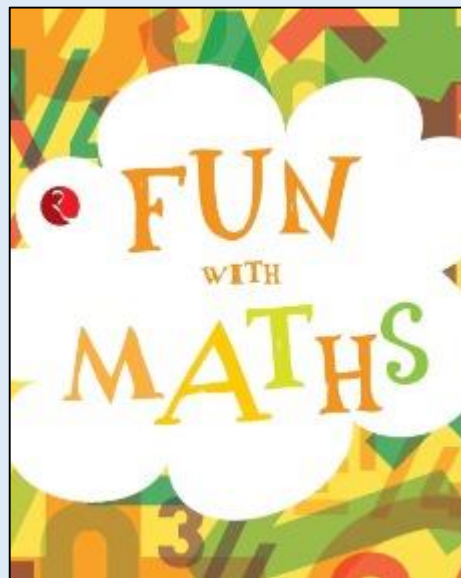
Fun with Maths

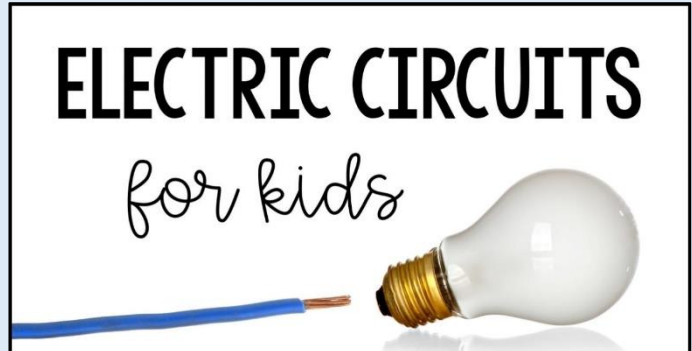
Electrical Circuits

Date and Time: May 31, 2023, 0900 to 0930 hrs.

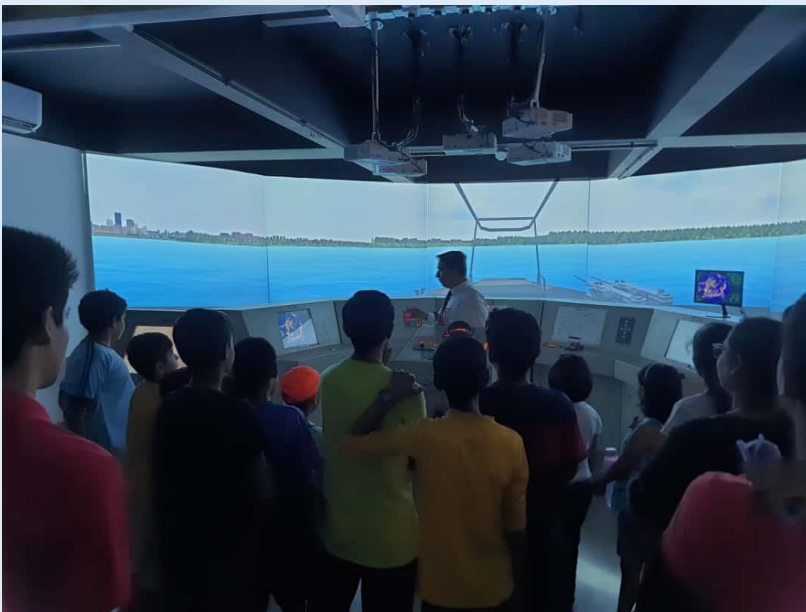

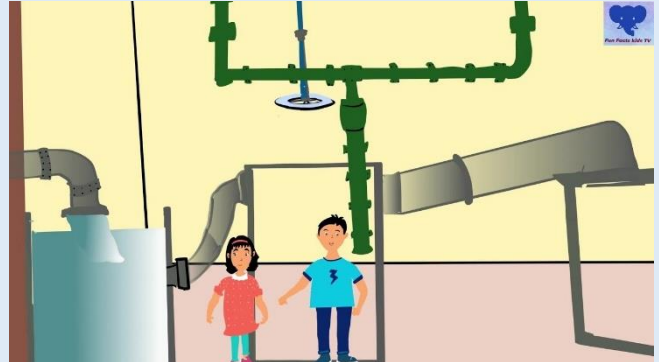


Visit to Water Filtration Plant
